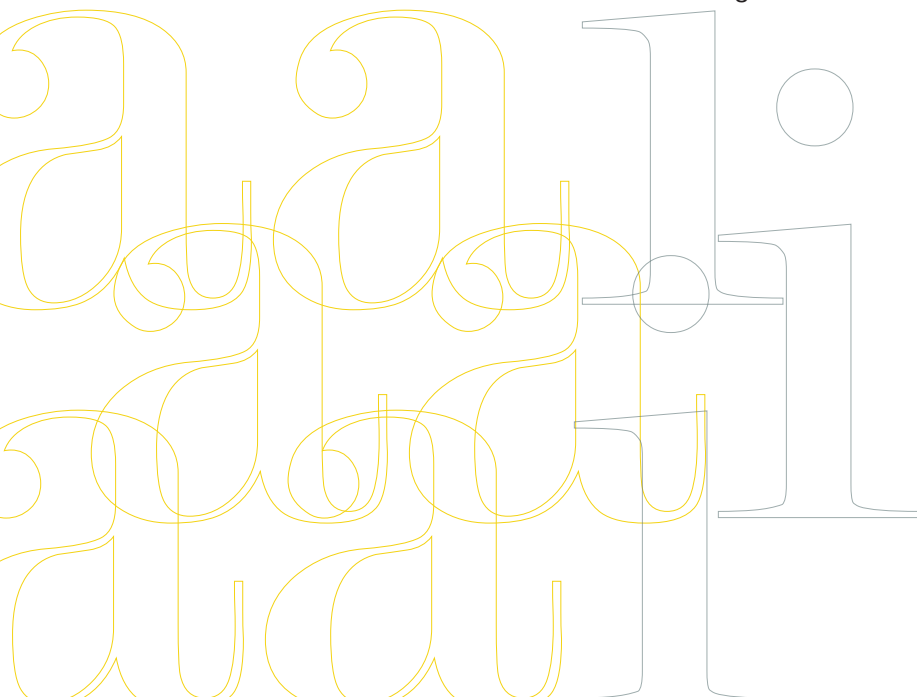




Visual Arts Department: New Student Application

Audition Requirements VisualArts Department:

Please bring a portfolio of work that reflects your strengths, individual growth, and personal interests as a visual artist. Your examples should reflect your knowledge of the **elements and principles of design**.

Please include:

1. A minimum of **five** works from observation: a still life, a self-portrait or a figure study, a landscape, a work using color, and a work emphasizing value.
2. A minimum of **two** pieces that demonstrate your creativity and imagination which may include work in any media, two or three-dimensional, painting, drawing, sculpture, printmaking, photography, digital media, and/or mixed media.
3. **One or more** sketchbooks, in particular those that reflect your creative process.

Be prepared to do a 20 minute sketch at the time of the audition.

Students will be notified of acceptance into the program within three weeks of interviewing.
